**Promote lifelong learning**

Monitor supply/demand

These aims are promoted through national commitments and voluntary pledges from stakeholders.




### EAfA is open to...






### **EAFA Green & Digital Transition Community**

- 9 x 1-1 meetings with members






### **EAFA Green and Digital Transition**



### Role of Cities and Regions in fostering apprenticeships and Work-Based Learning



- 1. Coordination and initiation of partnerships: education providers, employers and social partners
- **2. Funding and financial incentives**, also using EU funds to develop apprenticeships such as the Regional Development Fund and ESF, Erasmus+
- 3. Attractiveness and Inclusion: Policies to increase females in apprenticeships in certain fields, migrants etc.
- 4. Strategy: Integrate apprenticeships in broader development and work strategies, and build networks on trust
- **5. Outreach**: Access to potential employers and apprentices, campaigns, information sessions from a reliable source
- **6. Support to SMEs:** One of the main barriers, but services to support in administration, legal and financial aid is possible
- 7. Quality Assurance: Implementation of the European Framework for Quality and Effective Apprenticeships (2018)
- **8.** Data Analysis: Improve relevance of apprenticeships

- Negotiating a Pact For Skills Regional Partnership on Lifelong Learning
   Mobility
  - The Regional Skills Partnership for Lifelong Mobility commits to help to reach the goals of Europe on the Move, with 20% of VET learners by 2030 on mobilities and 20% of all mobilities for those with fewer opportunities.
  - The Partnership commits to networking with regional and local authorities to implement solid cooperation links in the field of VET mobility, with a focus on providing opportunities for apprenticeship mobility and on attracting new members to the Partnership

Oct 2023 – Feb 2024

1/ Declaration drafting: Close liaison with the PfS Secretariat at Ecorys to defined the challenge, ambition, activities & short-term key milestones, including the KPIs to measure the result of the KSIgune RSP activities.

March 2024

**2/ Launch of the partnership:** Official launch by the European Commission through a press release, LinkedIN group & PfS newsletter and KSIgune's dissemination within its ecosystem.

March – June 2024

3/ Engagement of the partnership: All 37 members to progressively endorse the KSIgune RSP commitments through the PfS website.

March 2024 onwards

**4/ Growth of the partnership:** Development of international and regional alliances to welcome new members to the RSP.

April - June 2024

**5/ Erasmus+ call application:** Elaboration of new demostrator project for the CCIs RSPs and the skills agenda, alongside 5 European organisations.



**6/ Implementation of the RSP activities:** skills intelligence, up- and re- skilling opportunies and communication and awareness-raising.


